We hope our meeting in January will help us decide on the way forward and encourage some of you to help us form a group to progress what should be a very project. A number of people have interesting already been updating the records of those who perished during the war with a view to correcting a few errors on the war memorial. We currently are in possession of copies of the Parish Monthly Magazine which covers all of the war years, the October & December 1914 editions have the names of those serving King and Country from Harrietsham or who were closely related to residents in the Parish. These magazines will be available to be read on the evening. Mike Bishop, who is the British Legion Poppy Appeal Organiser, will be joining us and other information will be supplied by John & Enid Betts and Frank Long.
